Isobel Materials List

1, 55 gram skein fingering weight silk or
silk/wool blend yarn

or

1, 55 gram skein fingering weight mohair
yarn

Size 5 US needles (if using silk yarn) or size
8 US needles (if using mohair yarn) or size
required to get gauge.

Row counter

Yarn needle

Crochet hook (for adding fringe)

Isobel Step by Step

Size: One

Finished Measurements: 5" x 70" (excluding fringe) for the silk scarf; 7" x 60" (excluding fringe) for the mohair scarf

Gauge: 6 sts = 1"; 6 ½ rows = 1" in silk, blocked; 4 ½ sts = 1"; 4 rows = 1" in mohair, blocked

Abbreviations found at end of pattern.

1. CO 31 sts on size 5 needles with silk (size 8 needles with mohair).

2. Knit the following set up rows. This will give you a row of eyelets, which you can use to pull fringe through after the scarf is knitted:

- 1 - Knit all sts.
- 2 - *K2TOG, YO, K1* to last stitch, K1.
- 3 - Knit all sts.
- 4 - Knit all sts.



3. After set-up, you'll knit in the main pattern until scarf measures desired length minus 1" or until you run out of yarn (remember to save some for the fringe!). This scarf expands a lot during blocking - for example, the silk scarf measured 52" long before blocking, and after blocking grew to 70" long. Keeping that in mind, repeat the main pattern until length is suitable, ending after row 12:

- 1 (RS) - *SKP, K2, YO, K2* x 5, K1.
- 2 (and all WS rows) - Purl all sts.
- 3 - As row 1.
- 5 - As row 1.
- 7 - K3, *YO, K2, K2TOG, K2* x 4, YO, K2, K2TOG.
- 9 - As row 7.
- 11 - As row 7.
- 12 - Purl.

4. After desired length is reached, knit the following 4 rows to finish the scarf:

- 1 - Knit all sts.
- 2 - Knit all sts.
- 3 - *K2TOG, YO, K1* to last stitch, K1.
- 4 - Knit all sts.

5. Bind off. Add fringe if desired by pulling fringe through the eyelets with a crochet hook and knotting.



Abbreviations

CO = Cast on

K = Knit

K2TOG = Knit two stitches together

RS = Right side

SKP = Slip one stitch knitwise, knit the next stitch, and then pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch and off the needle

sts = Stitches

WS = Wrong side

YO = Yarn over

... x 5 = Repeat the instructions inside the stars five times, or by however many times the pattern says



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
